



Enjoy-Nago-Bay Course

Distance 27.5km



This is the best course for beginner cyclists to enjoy authentic Nago.





①Hinpun Banyan Tree

The Hinpun Banyan Tree is 300 years old and has been watching the changes in the town as a symbol of Nago.



②Todoroki-no-taki Waterfall

Water is falling and splashing through huge igneous rocks. Many Ryukyu songs and 31-syllable Japanese poems were composed in praise of the beauty of this waterfall.



321st Century Forest Beach, Nago City

This is a beach where Nago citizens come to relax.
The whole family will enjoy it.
This is also a point where you can see a dynamic sunset view.



4Nago Castle Observatory

As you ascend the steep hill, the view of Nago Bay opens up and you look out over it from the high ground. The blue sea and the blue sky attracts visitors.

Intermediate Level

Haneji-naikai and Ogimi Round-Trip Course

Distance 52km



The course offers a view of Haneji-naikai Inland Sea, which is compared to Matsushima, one of the three most scenic spots in Japan, and the beautiful scenery of a bay from the Shioya Bridge.





①Arashiyama Observatory

The superb view composed of Kouri Island, Yagaji Island, and other islands of the Inland Sea is compared to Matsushima, one of the three most scenic spots in Japan. The wide panoramic view cannot be caught at one time.



②Warumi Bridge

At the end to the bridge, there is a bridge-side station Rikarikawarumi. You can have a break and enjoy local food and soft-serve ice cream on the terrace, while taking a bird's-eye view of the Strait of Warumi. The view of the Haneji-naikai Inland Sea from Warumi Bridge is very impressive.



3Michi-no-eki Ogimi

At this facility, there is a store where you can purchase agricultural and fishery products, including vegetables from the Yanbaru region, as well as specialty products. There is also a café restaurant where you can enjoy dishes made from these ingredients. It's a great place to refresh yourself.



4Shioya Bay

It is a quiet cove of smooth water surrounded by mountains and villages with rich nature. From Shioya Bridge at the entrance of the bay, you can enjoy the beautiful blue gradations of the seawater.




Motobu Peninsula and Nago Round-Trip Course

Enjoy the blue sea and bridges in the north!

This is a comparatively flat course for cruising the Motobu Peninsula, the Kouri Bridge, and the Haneji-naikai in Nago. Perfect for your first long bike ride!





Distance 65km



①Nago Municipal Market

There are about 30 stores, from a market selling local foods in the main, such as meat, fresh fish, vegetables, and fruits, to select shops selling the specialties of Nago City.



②Kouri Bridge

A bridge of about 2km that connects to Kouri Island. It is an impressive scenic point.



③Yagaji Branch Office

It is a landmark of Yagaji Island based on the history and culture of the region. The historic Kizuna no Kane bell celebrates visitors who launch out into the sea of life.




4 Haneji-no-eki

Tips for cycling in Okinawa







Be considerate of the local people and keep your speed down.



Cycling at night can be dangerous and can result in accidents and other problems. Try to avoid it.



Do not zigzag. Do not race.



Drink-driving and riding double on a bike are prohibited.



le Follow the traffic rules and drive



When going on a bicycle-accessible sidewalk, ride slowly on the carriageway side and do not obstruct pedestrian traffic.



It may be windy on the bridge and along the sea. Be very careful not to lose control of the handlebars.



Be sure to keep a good distance between

bicycles and pay careful attention to

what is ahead and behind you.

If it is unavoidable to cycle at night, be sure to turn on your front light and taillight.



Always wear a helmet for safety.
